Text: Isaiah 35:4-7

Title: "God Comes to Save"

Introduction

This world can be a fearful place. Fear not, for "God Comes to Save"

- I. Anxious hearts abound.
 - A. Life in this world is marked by anxiety.
 - B. Evil apparently triumphs.
- II. Into this world God comes to save.
 - A. "Be strong; fear not!" (v 4).
 - B. God's coming in the flesh to save you is the remedy for your fear.
- III. Jesus came into this world to reconcile and restore.
 - A. God does not extract us from creation.
 - B. Christ has redeemed us in creation, purchasing and winning us in body and soul for himself.
