There was no meeting in February. These are the current issues:

- Presented the congregational vote to the developers on the land sale terms. The strip of land 15' by 195' at the back of lot priced at \$13,455, not interested in selling the corner, and if there is no sale, the cut trees needs compensation, and we will take the fill if the timing and are needed preparation is complete. They need to present legal sale documents to move forward.
- Call Committee working on the Call. The process starts with gathering information on the church profile, it's mission, and it's needs. Sandy Bauer is chairing the committee with Jason Passow, Phil Klemp, Bill Flesch, Sharon Kazemba, David Fruechte, Dietrich Flesch, and Dave Hohenstein. Each have God-given talents that will lead to a successful search
- Congregation members will be asked some questions in a survey. Congregation members can also nominate candidates also; just ask for forms from Sandy. One of the Call requests is to canvas the community door to door with two questions 1. Our church will be receiving a new pastor soon. As we plan for our future, how can we serve you? 2. How can we pray for you and your family? Any volunteers that would help with this work let Sandy know 450-8668.
- Pray for discipline for your search committee and other church leaders. The search process will require a great deal of follow-through on the parts of individuals.
- The Elders are arranging for a vacancy and guest pastors. Dietrich Flesch has actively been inquiring about availability of pastors and a list the District has generated. Phil Klemp will organize the two additional Sundays services Pastor had done.
- Preschool has moved forward with an engineering survey for the environmental learning program.

Preschool News


Hello, from the preschool room!
